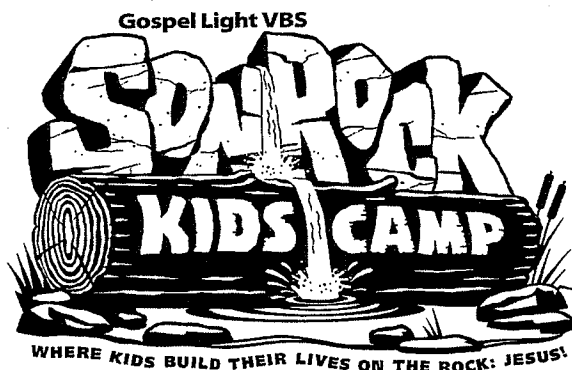
- Englewooders installed 8 installation kits in the homes of senior adults for Shepherds Center of the Northland.
